


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Madrid System







The Madrid System is Global

- 122 countries covered by 106 members
- Over 80% of world trade
- Recent accessions:
 - **2017**: Thailand, Indonesia
 - **2018**: Afghanistan, Malawi, Samoa
 - 2019: Brazil, Canada, Malaysia



The Madrid System is Convenient

Centralized filing and management

One application, one language, one set of fees

Protection in new markets as business strategy evolves



The Madrid System is Cost-Effective

One international application saves time and money

Avoid translations and multiple procedures



Costs

- Basic fee* (b/w or color reproduction of mark)
- Fees for designated Contracting Parties (dCP)
- => Example: Application for China, Germany, Russia and the USA, color, one class of goods: **CHF 1,979**
- * Applicants from <u>Least Developed Countries</u> benefit from a 90% reduction in the basic fee





The Hague System Benefits

One application, one language, one currency

■ Direct online filing (WIPO)

Centralized management



Costs

- Basic fee*, publication fee* and additional fee
- Fees* for designated Contracting Parties
- => Example: Application for the European Union, United Kingdom, Switzerland, Norway, the Russian Federation and the USA, one design with five reproductions
- * Applicants from Least Developed Countries benefit from a 90% reduction in the fees




