PCT Minimum Documentation: Current Situation

Compulsory Part

Rule 34.1(b)(i) – (b)(ii), Rule 34.1(c)(i) – 34.1(c)(iv), Rule 34.1(e)

Part Depending on ISA Working language

Rule 34.1(e)

Conditional Part

Rule 34.1(c)(vi), Rule 34.1(e)

An ISA-specific PCT Minimum Documentation whose content depends on:

- 1. The ISA's working languages; and
- 2. The availability of English language Abstracts of CN, JP, KR, RU & SU patent documents, as well as patent documents published in Spanish

3 Categories of PCT Min. Documentation Patents

1. Compulsory Patent Collections belonging to the PCT Minimum Documentation

2. Patents belonging to the PCT Min. Doc. <u>depending on the ISA's</u> Working Language

- for ISAs with at least 1 working language in Chinese:
 - + CN docs with no EN Abstracts
- for ISAs with at least 1 working language in Spanish:
 - + ES docs with no EN Abstracts
- for ISAs with at least 1 working language in Japanese:
 - + JP docs with no EN Abstracts
- for ISAs with at least 1 working language in Korean:
 - + KR docs with no EN Abstracts
- for ISAs with at least 1 working language in Russian:
 - + RU/SU docs with no EN Abstracts

3. Allowable Patent Collections that conditionally belong to the PCT Minimum Documentation

- First Filings in any other country published in the following languages:
 - English
 - French
 - German
 - Spanish having EN Abstracts

Currently:

- + AT 1st Filings
- + **AU** 1st Filings
- + CA 1st Filings
- + ES 1st Filings having EN Abstracts

Open Issues with Utility Models

Current situation:

only French utility certificates are part of the PCT Minimum Documentation

- Options for the future (for discussion):
 - including all utility models of the patent offices whose patent collections are part of the PCT Minimum Documentation provided that specific requirements are met (e.g. similar language requirements as for patent documentation)
 - excluding all utility models

Open Issues with Non-patent literature (NPL) 1/2

Current situation:

- The last official list of NPL publications belonging to the PCT Minimum Documentation was published in Part 4.2 of the WIPO Handbook on Industrial Property Information and Documentation in February 2010
- The list was conceived and defined for the paper era
- An updated version of this list was established by the EPO in collaboration with the PCT Minimum Documentation Task Force members – updated list posted on the wiki on 27.10.2017

Objective D:

"Recommend criteria and standards for the review, addition and maintenance of non-patent literature and traditional knowledge-based prior art (...)"

Open Issues with Non-patent literature (NPL) 2/2

- Options for the future (for discussion):
 - Regularly updated list complied by all ISAs and complying with specific requirements
 - No NPL with the exception of NPL contained in databases
 - meeting specific requirements and
 - for which inclusion in the PCT Minimum Documentation has been requested

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
