AttheeighthsessionoftheMeetingofInternational AuthoritiesunderthePCT("the Meeting"),heldinWashington,D.C.,fromMay5to9,2003,theUnitedKingdomPatent Office,initsroleascoordinatorofthe"virtual"taskforceonaPCTqualityframework, presentedtheinitialreportofthetaskforce (seedocumentPCT/MIA/8/5,whosecontentis identicaltothatofdocumentPCT/R/WG/4/12)totheMeeting.Followingthatpresentation, theOfficewouldliketoproposethefollowingamendmentstotheproposedframeworkset outinAnnex IofdocumentPCT/R /WG/4/12.

PROPOSEDAMENDMENTSTOTHEDRAFTFRAMEWORK

- 2. The term "testing" in paragraph 4(g) should be replaced by "assessing" so a sto give Authorities greater flexibility in meeting this requirement.
- 3. Paragraph5(d)shouldbemoved,asparagraph6(d),tofallwithinthe"Quality Assurance"sectionratherthanthe"Resources"section.

- 4. Paragraph17, which covers "Stage2" of "Reporting Arrangements," needs clarification to identify the general framework of the Reports. The paragraphshould be amended to read:
 - "Followingtheinitialreportinginstage1, annual reports should be prepared by each Authority, identifying the less on slearned and action staken, and making any recommendations in the light of the review."
- 5. There is a concern that the future development of the quality framework should be as inclusive a spossible, following the principles of consultation used in preparing the report of the task force. A new paragraph 18 entitled "Future Developments" should therefore be added, reading "Proposals for future changes to this framework should be made available by the International Bureau for comment by interested parties prior to their adoption."
 - 6. The Working Group is invited to consider the proposal sin paragraphs 2 to 5, above.
