

PROGRESS REPORT ON THE SURVEY OF COLLECTIONS OF PATENT DOCUMENTS AVAILABLE IN THE FRAMEWORK OF TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE PROJECTS FOR DEVELOPING COUNTRIES

Information from the Soviet Union

- 1. In addition to the information submitted by the state committee for inventions and discoveries of the USSR council of ministers in response to circular letter 2134, of February 28, 1975, the state committee announced to the international bureau, in a telex of July 10, 1975, that further information would follow in respect of backlog collections of patent documents available for use by developing countries (see annex a to this document).
- 2. with a letter dated September 12, 1975, the state committee informed the international bureau that the state committee could place at the disposal of developing countries files of specifications of soviet inventions from 1949 to 1957 and files of specifications of Great Britain patents from 1929 to 1967 in the form of microfilms (see annex b to this document).
 - 3. The interim committee is invited to take note of the information herewith submitted and is requested to consider this document in conjunction with document PCT/TAS/V/2.
