



Organization structure of the JPO












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Number of PCT Applications Filed with JPO





- In the capacity of RO/JP
 - <u>receives</u> international applications, other subsequent documents, and fees from applicants and the IB;
 - **checks formal requirements** under the PCT. When necessary, invites applicants to correct defects and sends notifications to applicants, the IB, and other Offices (ISAs);
 - **u** <u>sends</u> documents and fees to the IB and other Offices (ISAs) before the due date.
- In the capacity of ISA/JP and IPEA/JP
 - <u>receives</u> search copies of IAs, demand forms, other documents and fees
 - **u** <u>sends</u> reports, notifications, invitations and fees to applicants and the IB.





RO/JP

- n checks international applications on paper only, before the next step of digitizing; and
- **n** If necessary, corrects defects *ex officio* or invites the applicant to replace sheets containing the defects

RO/JP

- Converts paper documents to text data and image files;
- Stores the data and image files in the JPO's internal system; and
- n Assigns the international application number

RO/JP

- PCT are complied with and whether the required fees have been fully paid;
- **n** if necessary, invites the applicant to correct defects.
- (when the applicant responds to the invitation,) checks whether the response satisfies the requirements and was timely filed.

RO/JP

- n has only a couple of weeks to complete all the steps 1 to 6
 - the RO shall transmit the record copies of international applications in time for them to reach the IB by the expiration of the 13th month from the priority date, but
 - most of the applications are filed at the last minute during 12 months after the priority date
- n needs to check due dates for applicants to reply to invitations to correct international applications.

5. Time Management

- **ü** for applications on electronic form, transferring data by electronic means; or
- **ü** for applications on paper by mail.

6. Transmittal

RO/JP, once every week,

n transmits record copies, search copies, invitations and other documents to the IB, an ISA and applicants/representatives.

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
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- Who are RO/JP's Customers?
- n RO/JP is competent to receive international applications filed by
 - (i) the applicant residing in Japan;
 - (ii) the applicant who is a national of Japan; and
 - (iii) two or more applicants at least one of which resides in Japan or is a national of Japan.

n <u>Natural person or</u> <u>legal entity</u>



n For many applications, <u>agents</u> <u>are appointed</u>



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
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3. Time limit management as an ISA

Ensuring that rapidly increasing PCT applications are appropriately processed in a timely manner.




- PCT applications are distributed by Managers to Examiners with Schedule management sheets.
- Managers receive a consolidated schedule management sheet once a week.
- Top Management also receive it at the same time.





Drafting System (Sample)




Overview of time limit management as ISA



Management of timeliness as ISA is executed at several levels in the JPO.

- n Examiner Level
- Self-management using a schedule management sheet
- The drafting system generates an alert warning when the time limit for establishing ISR for an application is approaching.
- **n** Examination Division Level
- Schedule management by managers
- n JPO Level



As a result, the JPO has achieved timeliness in compliance with the Regulations under the PCT.

Schedule management sheet




Schedule management

- **ü** Schedule management sheet
- **ü** Consolidated schedule management sheet
- Short-term fluctuation in demand and backlog
- **u** Assigning multiple numbers of examiners to be in charge of the same classification.

Medium-to long-term fluctuation in demand and backlog

ü Changes in examiner's technical fields or transfer.



-NOTE-

The ISA must establish the ISR within 3 months of receiving a copy of the application (the "search copy"), or 9 months from the priority date (or, if no priority is claimed, from the international filing date), whichever expires later.
