

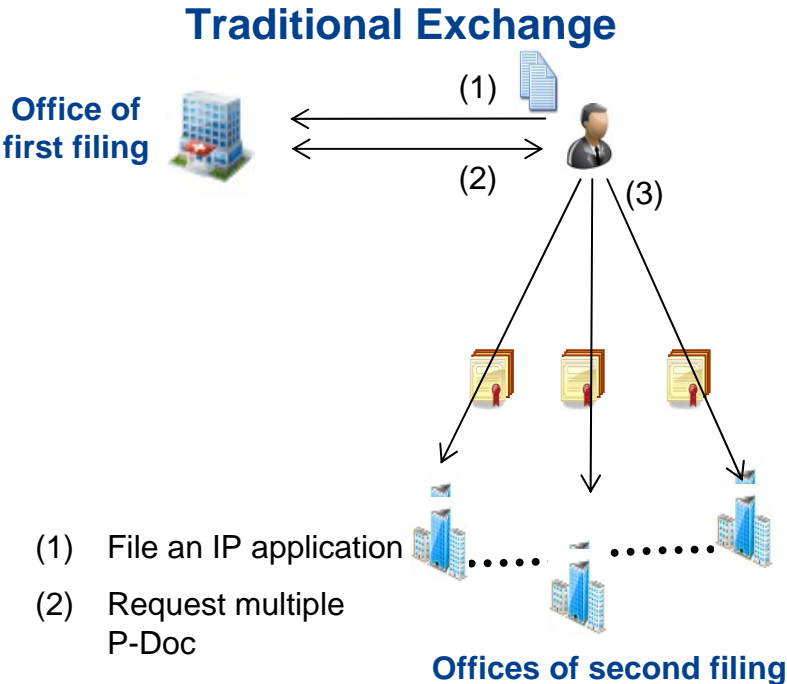


WIPO Digital Access Service (DAS) 2.0

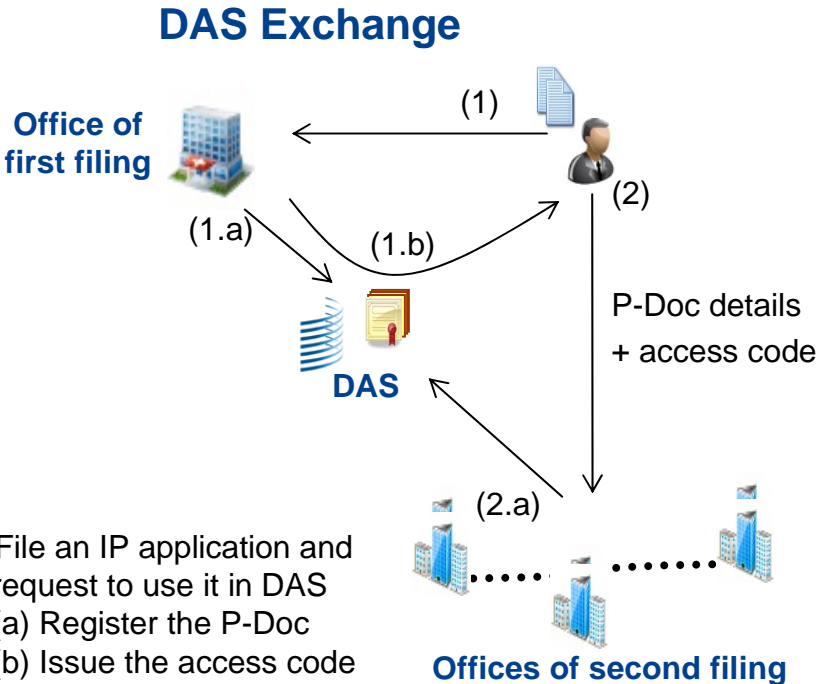

What is DAS and how it works

- To facilitate transfer of priority documents between national IP Offices and applicants



- (1) File an IP application
- (2) Request multiple P-Doc
- (3) File a subsequent application to each IP Office and furnish a P-Doc separately



- (1) File an IP application and request to use it in DAS
 - (a) Register the P-Doc
 - (b) Issue the access code
- (2) File a subsequent application to each IP Office with the P-Doc details and the access code
 - (a) Retrieve the P-Doc from DAS with the access code

Office Implementation

■ **As Office of First Filing**

- Administrative change in the national filing procedures to record the request to use DAS (access code generation is optional)
- IT change to implement the DAS registration via Trilateral Document Access for IP5 Offices only, via PCT Electronic Data Interchange Service (PCT-EDI) or manual process by using an web-based Office Portal for non IP5 Offices

■ **As Office of Second Filing**

- Administrative change in the national filing procedures to allow the applicant to supply the access code for DAS retrieval
- IT change to Implement the DAS retrieval registration via Trilateral Document Access for IP5 Offices only, via PCT-EDI or manual process by using an web-based Office Portal for non IP5 Offices

■ **Voluntary participation as OFF only, as OSF only or in both capacities**

■ **Office's decision to offer the service free of charge or not**

Actions taken by Applicants

- **Request the Office of first filing to use DAS**
 - Tick the appropriate checkbox on the filing form
- **Request the Office of second filing to use DAS**
 - Tick the appropriate checkbox on the filing form
 - Supply also the access code to the Office
- **Might use the WIPO portal**
 - to view the retrieval attempts made by Offices of second filing
 - to setup notifications to be informed of retrieval attempts by e-mails
