What is PATENTSCOPE Web-services?

- PATENTSCOPE Web-services is a service that allows machine to machine communications and is NOT a web-site
- Gives access to Published PCT International Applications:
 - Bibliographic information
 - Publically available documents
- Conforms to SOAP and WSDL standards

PCT PATENTSCOPE Web-services Implementation

- PATENTSCOPE Web-services can be used to source data at the time of National Phase Entry
- Access automatically the bibliographic data at the time of filing to help the user complete the national data entry
- Download the required documents from the PCT database automatically

PCT PATENTSCOPE Web-services - methods

- Available Methods:
 - **getAvailableDocuments** returns the list of available documents for the specified application number.
 - **getDocumentContent** returns the binary content of the document for the specified document id.
 - **getDocumentOcrContent** returns the binary content of the document for the specified document id, in text-based PDF format (high quality OCR).
 - **getDocumentTableOfContents** returns the list of page ids for the specified document id.
 - **getDocumentContentPage** returns the binary content for specified document and page ids.
 - **getIASR** returns the XML bibliographic summary for the specified application number.
