INTRODUCTION

- 1. The Standing Committee on Information Technologies (SCIT), at its sixth Plenary session held in January 2001 approved the Consolidated Special Rules of Procedure and Structure contained in the Annextodocument SCIT/7/14.
- 2. Inimplementingthesespecialrulesofprocedure, and using the practical experience gained, the International Bureauhasen countered two procedures that it recommends for amendment.

Recommendations

3. (a) WithreferencetothereportingmethodsestablishedbetweentheSCITandits two WorkingGroups(seeparagraph8),namelytheInformationTechnologyProjects WorkingGroup(ITPWG)andtheStandardsandDocumentationWorkingGroup(SDWG), thereappea rstobesomeinconsistenciesbetweenparagraph8andparagraphs11and14.Itis notedthatthemaximumnumberofmeetingsislimitedtotwiceayearforboththeITPWG andtheSDWGbutnominimumisspecified.InkeepingwiththeprinciplethatWorking Groupswillonlymeetifthereisaneedforthemtomeet,itisrecommendedthatthe consolidatedworkingmethodsoftheSCITbechangedtoreflectthefactthattheITPWGand

the SDWG may not necessarily meet on an annual basis. With this inmind, it is recommended that the word "annual" be deleted from the first sentence of paragraph 8 of the Consolidated Special Rules of Procedure and Structure.

- (b) WithreferencetothereportingmethodsoftheInternationalBureautothe ITPWG, it is recommended that he progress reports to the ITPWG will be made available on a six monthly basis as opposed to four monthly. This would then be more consistent with the International Bureau's own reporting mechanisms and would reduce substantially the overhead of preparing these reports. It is therefore recommended that paragraph to the Consolidated Special Rules of Procedure and Structure beamended accordingly.
 - 4. The SCITP lenary is invited to comment on and approve the recommendations contained in par agraph 3(a) and (b) of this document.
