The Standing Committee on Information Technologies (SCIT), at its sixth Plenary session heldin January 2001, considered the issue of the restructuring of the Standing Committee based on proposal set out indocument SCIT/6/2. Following the debate, the Secretariat was requested to prepare a document on consolidated special rules of procedure and structure for the next tession of the SCIT Plenary, which is contained in the Annex to this document.



SPECIALRULESOFPRO CEDUREANDSTRUCTURÐFTHESTANDIN G COMMITTEEONINFORMA TIONTECHNOLOGIES(S CIT)

approved by the Standing Committee on Information Technologies

- $1. \quad Subject to the following Special Rules of Procedure contained in this Annex, the \\ General Rules of Procedure of WIPOshall apply to the Stand in gCommittee on Information \\ Technologies (SCIT).$
- 2. The SCIT shall consist of a plenary session of the SCIT itself (herein after referred to as the "SCIT Plenary") and certain working groups. The SCIT Plenary may establish or dissolve working groups, as appropriate, keeping the number of the working groups to aminimum.
- 3. AllWIPOMemberStatesaswellasmemberStatesoftheParisUnionorBerneUnion thatarenotMemberStatesofWIPOshallbemembersoftheSCIT(i.e.,theSCITPlenary anditsWorkin gGroups).Inaddition,theAfricanIntellectualPropertyOrganization(OAPI), theAfricanRegionalIndustrialPropertyOrganization(ARIPO),theEuropeanPatent Organization(EPO),theBeneluxTrademarkOffice(BBM)andtheBeneluxDesignsOffice (BBDM),theEurasianPatentOrganization(EAPO),andtheEuropeanCommunities(on accountofitsresponsibilitiesinrespectoftheOfficeforHarmonizationintheInternal Market(TradeMarksandDesigns)(OHIM))shallbemembersoftheSCIT,providedthat they shallnothavetherighttovote.
- 4. The Director General of WIPO may and, if sor equested by the SCITPlenary, shall invite, as observers, interested intergovernmental organizations (other than member organizations mentioned above) and interested international and national non-governmental organizations, as well as organizations providing informations ervices in the field of intellectual property information, which are not accredited with observer status at WIPO meetings.
- 5. The SCITPlenary shall have a Chair and two Vice Chairs and shall elect them for a term of one year. Each Working Group shall have a Chair and two Vice Chairs and shall elect them for a term of one year.

- 7. ThemandateoftheSCITwillbeto givepolicyguidanceandtechnicaladviceonthe overallITstrategyofWIPO,includingWIPOstandardsandthedoc umentationaspectsof intellectualproperty,andthecoordinationandsteeringofallSCITworkinggroupsand/or taskforces.
- 8. The SCIT will meet once a year in ordinary session and will receive annual progress reports from the Working Groups on Information Technology Projects (ITPWG) and Standards and Documentation (SDWG). Recommendations from the Standing Committee may be passed either to the WIPO General Assembly, Program and Budget Committee, or directly to the Director General, as necessary. Member ship of the SCIT will be open to all WIPO Member States and observers, and the SCIT may recommend to the Director General to invite other representatives of the user community to attend as required. The SCIT is able to create working groups and/or task forces, as required.
- 9. The SCIT will be able to establish a mechanism of decision means, which may be delegated to its working groups, as required.

<u>ITProjectsWorkingGroup</u>

- 10. ThemandateoftheITProjectsWorkingGroup(ITPWG)willbetoadvise,withinthe frameworkoftheguidancegiventoitbytheSCIT,onthedesignandplanningphasesofIT projectactivities,monitortheimplementationofITprojects,tomakerecommendationstothe SCITontheinitiationofnewactivitie sandtoadvisetheSCITonissuesofprioritysettingfor projects.
- 11. TheITPWGwillmeetnomorethantwiceayearandwillbeopentoallWIPOMember Statesandobservers. Emphasis willbeplaced on the use of electronic working methods. Notices of convocation of meetings will include annotated agend as giving an indication of the preferred professional/technical competencies needed by delegates. The Secretaria twill make

availabletotheWorkingGroup,inelectronicform,four -monthlyprogressrepo rtsonall majoractivities,aswellasawork planforthecurrentbienniumandamedium -termplan coveringafour -yearperiod.Otherdocumentation,suchasresourceplans,wouldbemade availableonanas -neededbasis.

12. TheITPWGwillbeabletoest ablishTaskForcestocarryoutshort -term,focused activities.Emphasiswillbeplacedonworkingbyelectronicmeansbutphysicalmeetings maybeheld,asnecessary.

StandardsandDocumentationWorkingGroup

- 13. ThemandateoftheStandardsandDocu mentationWorkingGroup(SDWG)willbe to provideaforumtoadoptneworrevisedWIPOstandards,policies,recommendationsand statementsofprinciplerelatingtointellectualpropertydata,globalinformationsystem -related matters,informationservices ontheglobalsystem,datadisseminationanddocumentation, whichmaybepromulgatedontheauthorityoftheSCITorreferredtotheWIPOGeneral Assembly,viatheSCIT,forapproval.
- 14. AswiththeITPWG,theSDWGwouldbeopentoallWIPOMemberStates and observersandwouldmeetnomorethantwiceayear.Noticesofconvocationofmeetings willincludeannotatedagendasgivinganindicationofthepreferredprofessional/technical competenciesneededbydelegates.TheWorkingGroupwouldalsobeable tocreateTask Forcesonanas neededbasisthatwouldworkelectronicallywithphysicalmeetingsbeing held,asnecessary.

<u>ProjectTaskInitiation</u>

- 15. Fortheprocessoftaskinitiation,thefollowingstepswillbefollowed:
- (i) Considerationofa newsubjectoractivitymaybeinitiatedbyanyMemberState, observerorbytheInternationalBureaubysubmissionofawrittenprojectbrieftothe Secretariat,toinclude:
 - aclearindicationoftheproblemorspecificneedtobeaddressed
 - howthene edwasdetermined
 - theobjectivesofthetask
 - optionsforsolution
 - expectedbenefits;
 - $(ii) \qquad The Secretariat will then work, using electronic means, with either the ITPW Gorthe SDWG to produce a feasibility report to include:$
 - costestimates
 - risks
 - resourcerequirements
 - successfactors
 - theimplicationsofthetaskontheexistingITWorkPlanforthebiennium;
