INTRODUCTION

- 1. AtitssixthPlenarysessionheldinJanuary2001,theStandingCommitteeon InformationTechnologies(SCIT)consideredaseriesofproposalsfortherestructuringofthe StandingCommittee(seedocumentSCIT/6/2).Inconcludingitsdebateonthismatterthe SCITdecided(seedocumentSCIT/6/7,paragraph11)thattheSecretariatshould:
 - "...prepare...apaperontheoutstandingissues,containedindocumentSCIT/6/2,forthe nextsessionoftheSCIT."

OUTSTANDINGISSUESCONTAINEDINDOCUMENTSCIT/6/2

2. Inreviewing the contents of the above -mentioned document the Secretaria the lieves that the only outstanding is sues are those related to the proposed detailed working methods of SCIT working groups and task forces. The related text, taken directly from document SCIT/6/2, is contained in the Annex to this document for reference.

- 3. However,inreviewingthecontentsoftheConsolidatedWorkingMethodsforthe (seeAnnextodocumentSCIT/7/14)itisnotedthatspecificreferenceisalreadymadetothe creationandmanagementofworkinggroupsandtaskforces:
 - "8. ...TheSCITisabletocreateworkinggroupsand/ortaskforces,asrequired.
 - 12. TheITPWGwi llbeabletoestablishtaskforcestocarryoutshort -term,focused activities....
 - 14. ...The(SDWG)would also be able to create task forces on an asneeded basis that would work electronically with physical meetings being held, as necessary."
- 4. Recognizingthedynamicnatureoftheglobalinformationtechnologyenvironmentthe SCIThaslongunderstoodtheneedforanefficientandflexiblemanagementstructurefor WIPO's Information Technology andCommunication Program.Mindfulofthisrequir ement, theSecretariatbelievesthat,whencombinedwiththegeneralprinciplesofmonitoring, gatheringinputfromMemberStatesandanongoingdriveforefficiency,thereferencesto workinggroupsandtaskforcesalreadycontainedintheConsolidatedWo rkingMethodsof theSCITaresufficienttoallowtheStandingCommitteetofunctioneffectively.
- 5. Therefore, the Secretaria trecommends that a more pragmatic approach would be to first gains ome experience in the implementation of the Consoli dated Working Methods, and that should any procedures require adjustment, that the SCIT review these as and when appropriate.
 - 6. The SCITP lenary is invited to comment upon the contents of this document and approve the recommendation contained in paragraph 5, above.
