INTRODUCTION

- $1. \quad A tits last session, heldin January 2001, the Standing Committee on Information \\ Technologies (SCIT) had divided the tasks within the SCIT Work Program between its two working groups on Standards and Documentation and Information Technology Projects. The Working Groups were instructed to review their individual tasks, taking into the account the suggestions made during the SCIT Plenary meeting and to relay the outcome of their respective discussions to the next session of the SCIT.$
- 2. The Standards and Documentation Working Grouphas, on its Work Program, a number of tasks related to the support and maintenance of electronic data processing and exchange standards. Thes etasks highlight the expanding role and importance of information technology in intellectual property of fices of Member States. As a result, a number of Task forces were established to carry out those Tasks.

ISSUEFORCONSIDERATION

3. Theuseoftaskforcesindevelopingandmaintainingthesestandardsenhances participationofMemberStatesinthetaskswhilereducingthetimerequiredtoaccomplish specifictasks. Aproliferationoftaskforcesshouldbeavoidedasthismayleadtoa duplicationofeffortandmayresultinalackofconsistencybetweenstandards. The establishmentofasingletaskforcetoevaluateandmaintainthebroadgroupofWIPO electronicdataprocessingandexchangestandards, existingandfuture, wouldresultin nincreased efficiency in the standards maintenance process and better overall consistency in the standards themselves.

RECOMMENDATION

- 4. TheInternationalBureauwouldthereforerecommendthat:
- (a) theexistingtaskforceforTasksNos. 17a nd19haveitsmandatebroadenedto dealwithallmattersrelatedtoallcurrentandfutureWIPOelectronicdataprocessingand exchangestandards,inparticularTasksNos.13,17,18and19;
 - (b) theInternationalBureauserveasthetaskforceleader;
- (c) thetaskforcebereferredtoasthe"Electronicdataprocessingandexchange standards"taskforce.
 - 5. The SCITP lenary is invited to comment on the contents of this document and approve the recommendations contained in paragraph 4, above.
