INTRODUCTION

1. Atitslastsession,heldinJanuary2001,theStandingCommitteeonInformation Technologies(SCIT)haddividedthetaskswithintheSCITWorkProgrambetweenitstwo workingg roupsonStandardsandDocumentationandInformationTechnologyProjects.The WorkingGroupswereinstructedtoreviewtheindividualtasks,takingintotheaccountthe suggestionsmadeduringtheSCITPlenarymeetingandtorelaytheoutcomeoftheir respectivediscussionstothenextsessionoftheSCITinDecember2001.

CONSIDERATIONOFTHEWORKPLAN

2. TheInformationTechnologyProjectsWorkingGroup(ITPWG)atitsfirstsession,held inSeptember2001,consideredtheWorkPlantasksthat hadbeenassignedtoitbytheSCIT Plenary(seedocumentSCIT/ITPWG/1/2).

3. WithregardtothemajorityoftaskstheITPWG(seedocumentSCIT/ITPWG/1/13):

"decidedtodeleteTaskNos.1,9,12,14(firstpart),16and27fromitsWorkProgr ontheunderstandingthatthemonitoringandadvisoryroleoftheWorkingGroup,in respectoftheseactivities,wouldbemaintainedthroughtheprocessofprogress reportingtotheITPWG.Also,thatproposalsfornewactivitiescouldbeconsidered undertheSCITprocessfortaskinitiation."

INTELLECTUALPROPERTYOFFICEAUTOMATION

- Withthedeletionofthetaskslistedinparagraph3, above, three tasks remain on the ITPWGWorkProgram, allof which relate to the subject of intellectual propertyOffice automation. During the Working Group meeting the Secretaria treported that responsibility for this matternow fell under the mandate of the Intellectual PropertyOfficeAutomation Division, which had been created by the Director Generali nApril2001.Themandateofthe Division is three-fold; the development of a policy framework; the coordination of all automation-relatedactivities that WIPO carries out in its Member States; and the provision of technicalguidancein themodernization ofintellectualpropertyOffices.TheDivisionwas presented in the Draft Program and Budget for the 2002 -2003bienniumunder Main Program 12, Cooperation with Developing Countries, and w ouldworkcloselywiththis Sector.
- 5. TheITPWGrecognizedthattheestablishmentoftheIP OfficeAutomationDivision undertheaegisoftheCooperationforDevelopmentSectormeantthat the responsibilityfor tasksNos. 2,5andpa rtof14,nolongerlaywiththeInformationTechnologyProgram.
- 6. Inconside rationofthefactthatthetasksmentionedinparagraph 5,above,arecarried outbytheIP OfficeAutomationDivisionandit swork is closelyaligned with theCooperation forDevelopmentSector,whoseactivitiesarereportedto thePermanentCommitteeon CooperationforDevelopmentrelatedtoIntellectualProperty(PCIPD),itisrecommended thattheseremainingthreetasksberemovedfromtheTasklistoftheITPWG.
- 7. ShouldtheSCITPlenaryapprovetherecommendat ionsinparagraph5,above,the ITPWGwillnothaveanytasksonitsWorkProgram. Takingthis factintoaccount and mindful of the monitoring function of the Working Group and its emphasison electronic working methods, no physical meeting of the ITPWGh as been scheduled at this time. Should the SCITPlenary decide at a future date to reinstate the Work Planthrough the allocation of new tasks to the ITPWG, a decision will be taken on the convening of a meeting based on the Working Methods of SCIT.
