


What is work-sharing?

- Efficient examination practice
 - Patents are often filed in multiple jurisdictions for the same invention
 - Why not make use of work already done?
 - Use other work as a head start
 - Learn from other offices
 - Focus efforts on complex cases




Why do we need work-sharing?



Work-sharing initiatives

- IP Australia is involved in several work-sharing initiatives
 - Patent Cooperation Treaty
 - Vancouver Group
 - Global Patent Prosecution Highway
 - Australia New Zealand Single
 Economic Market



Work-sharing initiatives

- Vancouver Group
 - IP Offices of Australia, Canada and United Kingdom
 - Mutual Exploitation
 - Rely on work done by another VG office
 - 'Office-driven' approach
 - On-line access to work





Work-sharing Infrastructure

- Need a way of accessing earlier information
 - WIPO Patentscope
 - Applicant supply
 - Online service, e.g. WIPO CASE



WIPO CASE

- Centralised Access to Search and Examination
 - Portal to work of other offices
 - Initial collaboration between the Vancouver Group and WIPO
 - Membership is expanding, participating offices are;
 - Depositing: AU, CA, UK, CN, IL
 - Accessing: NZ, MN, VN, SG, MY, PH
- Link to IP5 One Portal Dossier
 - In pilot phase with JPO



WIPO CASE Current Functionality

Data/Document Delivery

- Web Service links to Office data/documents
- Upload of bulk data/documents for storage in WIPO CASE

Patent Family search

'Simple' and 'Extended' search

Application details

- View bibliographic information
- View or download dossier documents


Citation information




