1. Requirements for Deposit

If the invention refers to a product or a process involving biological material and the invention cannot be understood and carried out, as described, by a person skilled in the art, it must be accompanied by a deposit of the said material.

(Article 29, Andean Community Decision 486 - Common Industrial Property Regime)

2. Time of Deposit

The material shall be deposited by the filing date or, where priority is claimed, the date of application.

(Article 29, Andean Community Decision 486 - Common Industrial Property Regime)

3. Duration of Storage

No provision.

4. Conditions for the Furnishing of Samples

The deposit of biological material shall be valid for granting a patent only if it is carried out in such a way that any interested person may obtain samples of that material by the date of expiration of the eighteen months period after the filing date or, where priority is claimed, the date of application.
