In reply to your circular SCIT 2474 of October 27, 1999, we have pleasure to inform you that we are contented with the fact that the International Bureau has taken into consideration the information of the Russian Agency for Patent and Trademarks concerning the changes with respect to the titles of two journals of the PCT List of Periodicals (PCT identification numbers 037 and 222). We support the proposal of the International Bureau to continue the JOPAL Project and have no objection against the date suggested by International Bureau for coming into effect the amended PCT List of Periodicals.

We agree also with a change in the title of the former bilingual Journal of Organic Chemistry of Russia (PCT identification number 178).

But unfortunately we have to inform you that we are unable to take over responsibility for selecting articles from PCT journals 205, 208, 211, 219, 222 (new number 233) formerly assigned to Canadian Intellectual Property Office (CIPO).
