

For the Quality Subgroup, an informal agenda and information concerning preparations for the meeting will be made available through the PCT Quality Subgroup wiki discussion forum. As has been the case for recent meetings, the draft agenda for the Quality Subgroup includes an item on paired review of quality management systems. Your Office is invited to participate in the paired review sessions at the upcoming meeting. These sessions will take place on June 13 and 14, 2022 as breakout sessions on the Zoom platform. As the paired review sessions will be held before the main session of the Quality Subgroup, the scheduling will allow for pairings of International Authorities from more distant time zones than the previous meeting of the Subgroup. If your Office wishes to participate, you should indicate this by sending an e-mail to pct.mia@wipo.int by May 13, 2022, at the latest. This will allow adequate time for participating Authorities to review the QMS report of the Authority that they have been assigned and provide an opportunity to prepare for the sessions.
