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
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


PCT Delays Costs and Preserves Options --Good for All Applicants




PCT – Timeline #1 – Using Provisionals

- File US as Non-Provisional and via PCT
- Get PCT Search before Non-Prov. Exam
- Consider using two different claiming strategies.
- Disclose co-pending applications to USA examiner.




PCT – Timeline #2 – Using Provisionals

- •File US only via PCT: Bypass Continuation (Sec. 111) or Nat. Stage Entry (Sec. 371), or both.
- •Consider using two different claiming strategies.
- •Early By-Pass might minimize file history effect of PCT.
- •Disclose co-pending applications to USA examiner.




PCT – Timeline #3 – Using Provisionals

- File Multiple US Provisionals; Save \$800/appln.
- File PCT at <12 Months; Claim Multiple Priority
- Publish via PCT in English language (102(e))
- Pursue US Continuation or US Nat. Stage or Both Decide Which Claims for Which Exam Time



PCT – Timeline #4 – Using Provisionals


- File US Provisional, Use PCT for USA, Delay USA Exam and Use PCT for Preliminary Examination
- Get Search from US or EP
- Publish via PCT in English language (102(e))
- Choose EP or US for Prelim. Exam. During Chap. II





PCT – Timeline #5 – Using Provisionals

- File US Provisional & PCT <12 Months
- Get Search from US or EP
- Publish via PCT in English language (102(e))
- Make NO Demand for Chapter II
- Examine US First Instance during National Stage





PCT – National Stage Entry at 30/31 Months Choosing Wisely

- PCT has preserved options. Now what?
- Year 3 is most costly year of patent application life -- translations, national stage fees, and associated law firms.
- Patent attorneys need to be economic futurists.
- Use macroeconomic country trends and microeconomic industry trends.



5-10-15 Maintenance Principle

- Preserve all patentable inventions for at least 5 years.
- Preserve only product line patent protection past 10 years.
- Preserve only technology platform patent protection past 15 years.
- Scope of patent protection affects horizon of economic prediction.
