Additionally, ILPO intends to join the WIPO CASE system for exchanging search and examination results with other offices.

Benefits the ILPO sees in joining WIPO CASE:

- Improved transparency and quality of work;
- Efficient Office driven work sharing;
- Centralized access to search and examination reports from multiple jurisdictions;
- Minimal duplication of work through the use of common WIPO standards.

External databases for retrieving information relevant to search and examination: EPOQUENET, Thomson Innovation, STN, Derwent (via STN), Questel and access to all freely available databases.

## Confidentiality of communications between clients and their patent advisors

There are no provisions in the law regarding this matter, though private organizations might have best practices recommendations. Courts may rule in favor of confidentiality in view of there being a fiduciary relationship.
