In accordance with the Circular 8775 dated on June 11, 2018 which invites further inputs or questions on the issue of the protection of GUIs, Icons and Typeface/Type Font designs, the Japan Patent Office would like to submit a few additional questions on (2) "the methods allowed by offices for the representation of animated designs."

The questions are as follows:

Question 1-1:

When filing a design application on an animated design (changeable images) in the country that allows applicants to submit video files, do applicants need to submit only a video file to disclose the details of the animated design? Or, are they required to submit drawings of static images representing their animated designs mandatorily and video files voluntarily?

Question 1-2:

If the answer to Question 1-1 is that applicants are required to submit drawings of static images as well as video files, how are the representations of the video files handled in relation to the scope of the design rights? Are they treated as those that directly represent the scope of the design rights or as just reference information?

Question 1-3:

If the answer to Question 1-2 above is that the representations of video files are treated as reference information, specifically what kind of reference information are they treated as? For example, as a reference to identify specific state of change/flow or specific patterns/colors of the designs?
