


Heidelberg-Mannheim, Germany

Heidelberg-Mannheim is the sixth-ranked cluster, out of 9 German clusters, that falls within the top 100 S&T clusters in 2023. It filed 1,968 PCT applications and published 6,914 scientific articles, both per 1 million inhabitants over the last five years, making it the:

62nd largest science and technology cluster in 2023 (down one spot from 2022)

26th S&T cluster by intensity (relative to population density) in 2023 (up two spots from 2022)

46% of Heidelberg–Mannheim's PCT patent applications are filed in collaboration with other inventors, with Frankfurt am Main, Karlsruhe and Stuttgart emerging as the top collaborative locations.

81% of Heidelberg–Mannheim's scientific articles are published in collaboration with other organizations, with the top three collaborating locations being Cologne, Munich and Frankfurt am Main.
