

Kanazawa, Japan


Kanazawa is the fourth-ranked cluster, out of 4 Japanese clusters, that falls within the top 100 S&T clusters in 2023. It filed 4,184 PCT applications and published 3,905 scientific articles, both per 1 million inhabitants over the last five years, making it the:

86th largest science and technology cluster in 2023 (down six spots from 2022)

11th S&T cluster by intensity (relative to population density) in 2023 (up one spot from 2022)

14% of Kanazawa's PCT patent applications are filed in collaboration with other inventors, with Tokyo-Yokohama, Osaka-Kobe-Kyoto and Nagoya emerging as the top collaborative locations.

68% of Kanazawa's scientific articles are published in collaboration with other organizations, with the top three collaborating locations being Tokyo-Yokohama, Osaka-Kobe-Kyoto and Nagoya.
